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



We identified 9 different research-policy engagement practices, that speak to three different ways of thinking about how to improve evidence use in government



 *c Non-profit initiative (7)



Dominant topics of research-policy engagement initiatives (top 15)




57 organisations have made evaluations of their work available in the public domain


13% of organisations who have shared evaluations

5% mixed peer reviewed and grey literature




About 16% of the literature we found had been peer reviewed

We found pockets of learning from evaluations that offer a rich and nuanced picture



Often new initiatives fail to draw on this existing learning. Many organisations funded multiple activities, used different policy engagement practices, and didn't articulate clear goals.

To make the most of growing investment in research-policy engagement, we need clearer evidence about what works and how organisations can support each other to achieve shared goals.
